MEDICAL MILEAGE TAX EXEMPTION

1. Trips to and from appointments
2. Miles to perform charitable service

Do you claim medical expenses to get tax reimbursement? If so, then **mention medical mileage on your income tax return** as well. For instance, the trips to and from appointments, transportation expenses incurred by a parent for accompanying a child, etc. This is not all.
